



Ryan is the son of Patrick and Kim and is graduating from Capital High School. During high school, Ryan was on the soccer, basketball, football, and track



Community Garden Update

If you are eager to get outdoors, but don't have space in your own yard, consider renting a garden plot from Our Redeemer's Community Garden. Plots are available for \$25. This fee covers automatic watering and some tilling. Renters are responsible for planting, weeding, and harvesting their own plots.
